

Students Feedback on Academic performance and ambience of the College

> Data Collection for 2022-23:

Feedback is a great reinforce for learning and achievement (Mathew B.P., 2020). It has a significant impact on students' academic achievement. Positive feedback can motivate others to take action, which benefits both teaching and learning. Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya collects the Students' feedback on *Academic performance and ambience*. The input was collected in an online google form from Students of the college and then assessed using the Likert scale's arithmetic computation. Finally, the findings have been considered about development, the teaching-learning process, and other critical topics. A total of 102 Students from all department of the college have answered about the 15 parameters of the *Academic performance and ambience*.

Methodology:


To judge these aspects, the rating scale technique has been adopted with five different points – excellent, good, Satisfactory, poor, and very poor. For proper quantification, arithmetic scale (5, 4, 3, 2, and 1) has been assigned against this five-point scale, five (5) for 'excellent', four (4) for 'good,' and so on. Different numbers (n5 for 'excellent', n4 for 'good' and so on) of opinions have been quantified with the help of the following equation. Total score of 'Understanding of the Course' = $(5 \times n5 + 4 \times n4 + 3 \times n3 + 2 \times n2 + 1 \times n1)$ /N. Thereafter all the derived scores have been presented in table no. 1 and has haven used for evaluation.













8. The role of the Institution in encouraging the student-centric methods for enhancing learning experiences



Analysis Report of the Students Feedback:

- The analysis of the students feedback on "Academic performance and ambience of the institution" depicts satisfactory responses in all parameters as the composite score stands above four (Good) in all cases. However, slight differences have been found among the parameters.
- Among all parameters, "The Quality of teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates cognitive, social & emotional growth" stands at the top with a score of 4.43 whereas "The role of the central library of the college in providing comprehensive computerized services" gets the lowest score with 4.09.
- Response of the students to the parameter "Overall quality of teaching-learning experience of the institution" depict good score (4.41) signifying the excellent performance of the institution.
- > Students feedback regarding the role of the institution in encouraging participation in sports and extra-curricular activities gets excellent with a score of 4.40.
- Response of the students is comparatively low with a score of 4.12 in the parameter "The role of the Institution in skill enhancement, career counselling and placement"
