DR. BHUPENDRA NATH DUTTA SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA: AN OVERVIEW:

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya is a rural college established in 1996 and is associated with the name of Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta, the younger brother of the Vedantic Scientist Swami Vivekananda and a pioneering personality of the glorious Bengal Renaissance. Dr. Dutta's involvement with Hatgobindapur and its surrounding areas went back to the pre-independence days when he was involved to bring about the much-awaited socio-economic development of this rural area. To commemorate his work and contribution, a decision had been taken in a mass meeting in 1983 to establish a General Degree College in the name of Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta and thereafter Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya was established in 1996, as a State Govt. Aided College affiliated to the University of Burdwan.

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta, the younger brother of Warrior Monk Swami Vivekananda was born in Kolkata (Calcutta) in September, 4, 1880. Bhupendra Nath was a noted revolutionary, political thinker, sociologist and foremost figure among the Indian intellectuals. He was associated with Rishi Aurobindo and the Jugantar Group of revolutionaries. Bhupendra Nath Dutta joined the All-India Revolutionary Society and his revolutionary consciousness was expressed in his writings in the weekly *Jugantar* and *Sonar Bangla* for which the British authorities jailed him. At the end of his imprisonment, he sailed to America and after graduating from the New York University in 1912, he earned a Masters' Degree from the Brown University in 1914. During his visit in Southern Europe in 1915, he came across other Indian revolutionaries and was elected as the Secretary of the Berlin Committee for the period of 1916 – 1918. Simultaneously, with his revolutionary activities, he carried out academic research in Sociology and Anthropology that earned him his Doctorate Degree from Hamburg University in 1923. This immensely gifted revolutionary scholar authored a number of books that included among other Indian Social System (3 volumes), "Dialectics of Hindu Ritualism" and "Agony of the Age". He was regarded as the most illustrious figure of the Bengal Renaissance and a dedicated nationalist. A firm believer in socialism, he had propounded the theory of the emergence of feudalism in the Indian context of the early medieval period. He had worked extensively on the nature of land holding in India and particularly was passionate about the land economy of Bengal that found reflection in his celebrated work entitled, "Dialectics of Land-Economics of India." Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta was involved in championing the cause of farmers and agricultural workers. One of the Presidents of Bengal Provincial Kisan Sabha, he was elected President twice of All India Trade Union Congress. Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta dedicated his life for the cause of socio-economic advancement of the rural poor and the under-privileged. He passed away at the age of 81, on December 25, 1961.

VISION AND MISSION OF THE COLLEGE:

- (a) To open new avenues for the rural students for enabling them to pursue higher education;
- (b) To diffuse knowledge through publishing literary articles and organizing festivals, seminars, workshop etc.
- (c) To impart higher education to socially backward sections of the society;
- (d) To introduce job-oriented courses to promote self-employment opportunities;
- (e) To give assistance to poor SC, ST and OBC students to continue their higher studies;
- (f) To uplift the rural poor through the non-formal vocational courses of education;

REPORT OF THE PRINCIPAL:

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya established in the name of the younger brother of great Indian philosopher morning memorable monk Swami Vivekananda, always is in aim of attaining the steady upliftment in all aspects. On spot counselling from time to time in almost all the gathering platforms ranging from festive occasions to general assemblage, from the very beginning of all the classes, have made the students attend more and more classes. Propaganda from all levels is in vogue in any type of seminar ranging from celebration to special lecture, especially after the unprecedented and disastrous pandemic scourge.

We are in constant touch of maintaining the cleanliness of the campus to retain its beauty. Restoration strategy of this lush green landscape along with grassy playfield all the year round is on by planting new saplings under the permanent wire-caged single as well as long enclosure to protect those from the unprecedented damaging effects by hooves and mouth of the bovine animals. We have again appealed to the Block Development Officer (BDO) to arrest the everlasting drainage problem of the college pool as one major village drainage channel cause a havoc by destroying fishes and forest during rains every year. The strategy of mitigation of this problem will help to maintain the health of the plants and wild animals therein.

The college has been trying to increase the employability of the students by introducing newer Add-on courses in near future on various lucrative and useful arenas. Amin Survey, GST courses, Artistic handicrafts and Rural Empowerment will help a lot in this respect. Apart from such endeavour we have started dialogue with the notable training provider along with our own Career Counselling Programmes.

We are approaching the local administration for a solar submersible pump set for drinking water purposes in an instant manner. Again we have approached our major bank of transaction i.e., SBI to provide our student cold water dispenser facility in the capacity of their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) project.

We have done a beautification programme of the central office veranda by pot planting of flowering and non-flowering plant species and adornment with our great personalities by glass etching techniques.

Office staff of the college is sincere enough to perform their duties carefully and function all the year round even in recess periods of summer and winter. They are competent enough to submit all kinds of papers and bills with utmost efficiency.

In the financial year 2022-23 a sum of Rupees One Lakh Seventy six Thousand Six Hundred Forty two (₹ 1,76,642) was unspent in connection with RUSA rest amount out of Rupees two crores (₹ 2,00,000,00). We have spent Rupees One Lakh Sixty two Thousand Six Hundred Forty only (₹ 1,62,640) for purchase of computer and related accessories and Rupees Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred Two (₹13,802) to purchase laboratory equipments. Utilisation Certificate (UC) has already been submitted as desired from the sanctioning authority. All have done maintaining procedural details.

In the same financial year (2022-23), one Minor Research Project came with Sidhu-Kanho-Birsa University as Co-Principal Investigator of our Prof. Dr. Abhijit Roy. It was sanctioned on June, 11, 2022 by The West Bengal University of Juridical Sciences amounting to Rupees Four Lakhs (₹ 4,00,000) (F. No. RP/06/2022). The UC has already been submitted by the concerned University

In March, 19, 2023 another MRP came to his credit (Dr. Abhijit Roy) from ICSSR with an amount of Rupees Five Lakhs (₹ 5, 00,000) and as reported due UC will be submitted in the month of May, 2024.

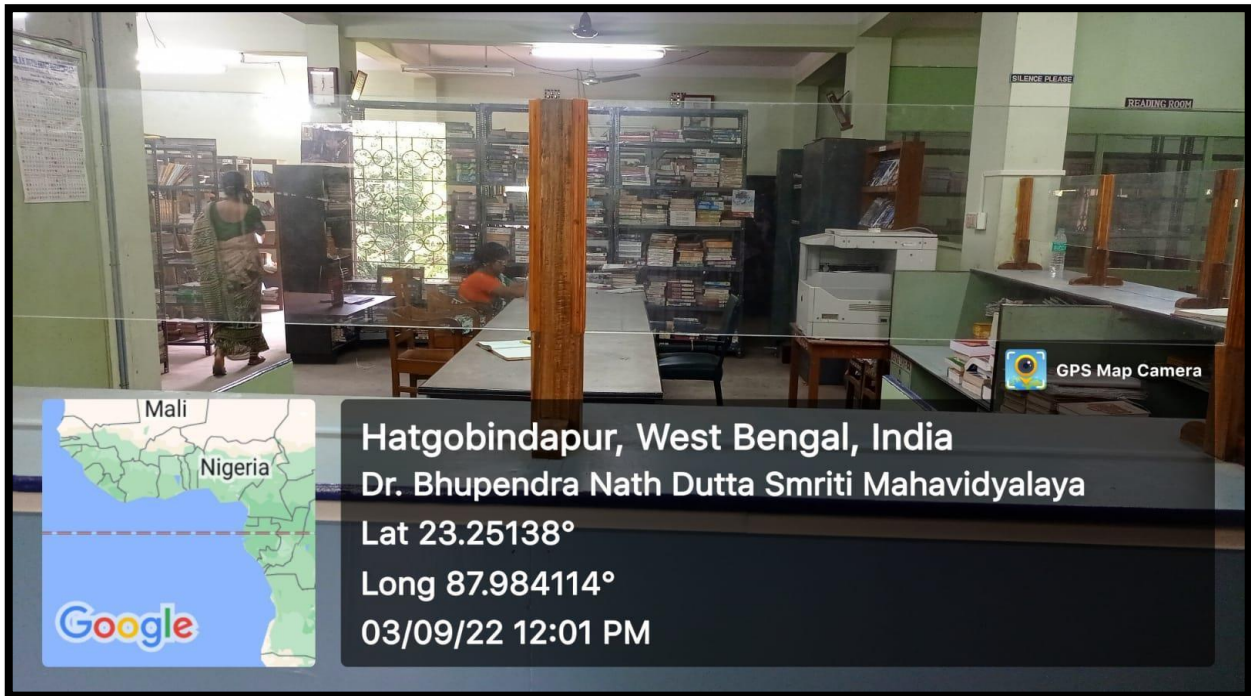
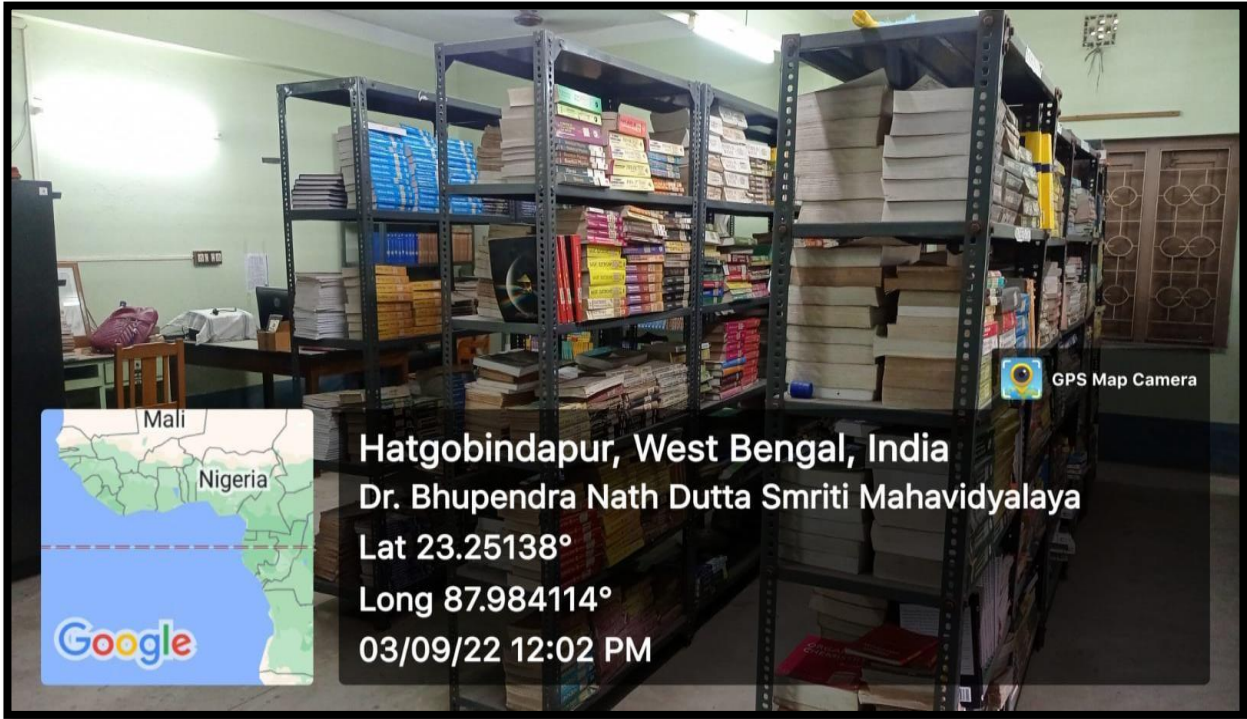

COLLEGE LIBRARY:

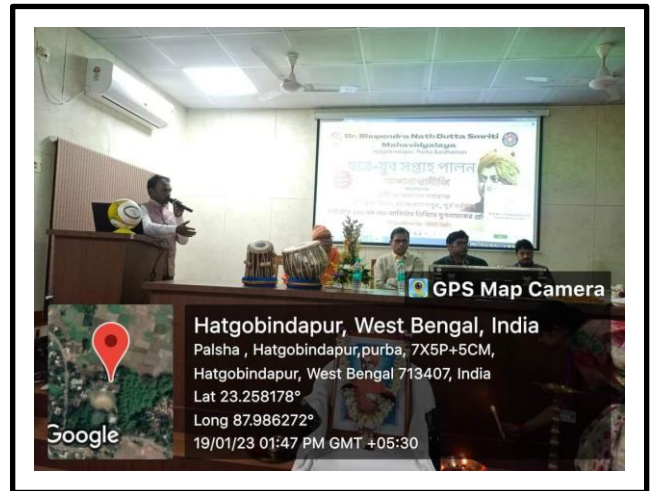
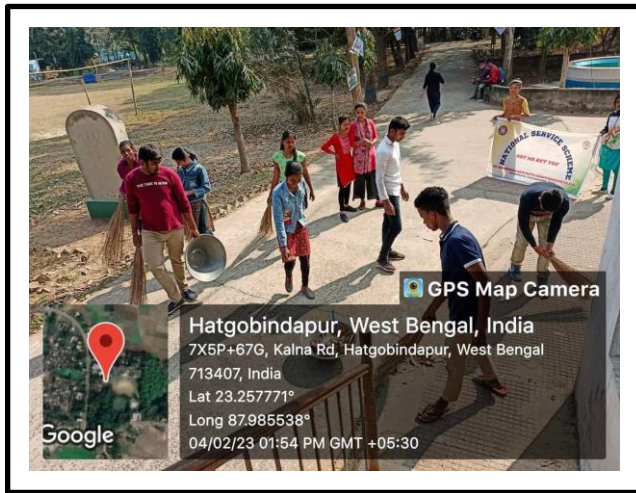

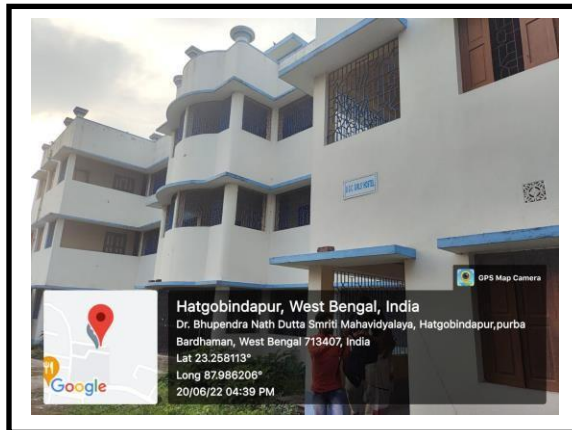
NETAJI SUBHAS OPEN UNIVERSITY (NSOU):

HOSTEL FACILITY:
