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DR. BHUPENDRA NATH DUTTA SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA: AN OVERVIEW:

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya is a rural college established in 1996 and is associated with the name of Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta, the younger brother of the Vedantic Scientist Swami Vivekananda and a pioneering personality of the glorious Bengal Renaissance. Dr. Dutta's involvement with Hatgobindapur and its surrounding areas went back to the pre-independence days when he was involved to bring about the much-awaited socio-economic development of this rural area. To commemorate his work and contribution, a decision had been taken in a mass meeting in 1983 to establish a General Degree College in the name of Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta and thereafter Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya was established in 1996, as a State Govt. Aided College affiliated to the University of Burdwan.

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta, the younger brother of Warrior Monk Swami Vivekananda was born in Kolkata (Calcutta) in September, 4, 1880. Bhupendra Nath was a noted revolutionary, political thinker, sociologist and foremost figure among the Indian intellectuals. He was associated with Rishi Aurobindo and the Jugantar Group of revolutionaries. Bhupendra Nath Dutta joined the All-India Revolutionary Society and his revolutionary consciousness was expressed in his writings in the weekly Jugantar and Sonar Bangla for which the British authorities jailed him. At the end of his imprisonment, he sailed to America and after graduating from the New York University in 1912, he earned a Masters' Degree from the Brown University in 1914. During his visit in Southern Europe in 1915, he came across other Indian revolutionaries and was elected as the Secretary of the Berlin Committee for the period of 1916 – 1918. Simultaneously, with his revolutionary activities, he carried out academic research in Sociology and Anthropology that earned him his Doctorate Degree from Hamburg University in 1923. This immensely gifted revolutionary scholar authored a number of books that included among other Indian Social System (3 volumes), "Dialecties of Hindu Ritualism" and "Agony of the Age". He was regarded as the most illustrious figure of the Bengal Renaissance and a dedicated nationalist. A firm believer in socialism, he had propounded the theory of the emergence of feudalism in the Indian context of the early medieval period. He had worked extensively on the nature of land holding in India and particularly was passionate about the land economy of Bengal that found reflection in his celebrated work entitled, "Dialectics of Land-Economics of India." Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta was involved in championing the cause of farmers and agricultural workers. One of the Presidents of Bengal Provincial Kisan Sabha, he was elected President twice of All India Trade Union Congress. Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta dedicated his life for the cause of socio-economic advancement of the rural poor and the under-privileged. He passed away at the age of 81, on December 25,1961.

VISION AND MISSION OF THE COLLEGE:

- (a) To open new avenues for the rural students for enabling them to pursue higher education
- (b) To diffuse knowledge through publishing literary articles and organizing festivals, seminars, workshop etc.
- (c) To impart higher education to socially backward sections of the society
- (d) To introduce job-oriented courses to promote self-employment opportunities
- (e) To give assistance to poor SC, ST and OBC students to continue their higher studies
- (f) To uplift the rural poor through the non-formal vocational courses of education

REPORT OF THE PRINCIPAL:

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya established in the name of the younger brother of great Indian philosopher Morning Memorable Swami Vivekananda, always is in aim of attaining the gradual upliftment in all respect. Direct Counselling in almost all the gathering platforms ranging from joyous occasion to general assemblage, time to time from the very beginning of all the class, have made the students to attend more classes. Daily propaganda from all levels is in vogue, especially after the unprecedented and disastrous pandemic scourge.

We are in constant endeavour of maintaining the cleanliness to retain the beauty of the campus. Restoration strategy of this lush green landscape is on by planting newer saplings under the permanent weir-caged enclosure to protect those from the unwanted damaging effect. We have appealed to the Block Development Officer (BDO) to arrest the long-lasting draining problem of the college pool as a civil drainage channel cause problem during the monsoon months. This mitigation will help to maintain the health of the plants and animals therein.

The college authority has been trying to enhance the employability of the students by introducing newer courses such as Conversational English; Yoga, Naturopathy and Physiotherapy; Amin Survey; GST Course; Artistic Handicrafts and Rural Empowerment; Remote Sensing and GIS. Apart from such introduction programmes, we have started Career Counseling sessions with Training Organizations for final semester students.

We are going to reopen Cyber Centre to ease the copying facility as well as Online Form Fillup ranging from college related activity to employment purpose. We have been relocating our Medical Support Centre in front of the office gate instead of the near North-East corner position, to access it in greater number not only for the students and staff of the college but also to the nearby downtrodden people.

College Office Staff do their activities with utmost sincerity, instead of the huge volume of ever increasing task in the event of Semester System and the resultant busy schedule.

In the financial year of 2020-21, a Grant of Rs.175,000 (1.75 lakhs) was released from the Member of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS) in continuation of the previously received Rs. 5,25,000 (5.25 Lakhs) out of the total allotment of Rs. 7,00,000 (7 Lakhs) for building of Toilet Blocks of Boys and Girls Students. The entire amount was exhausted and UC has already been submitted to the concerned authority. Moreover, out of the allotted Rs. 1,00,000 (1 Lakh) in Minor Research Project (MRP) by ICSSR, we had received the remaining amount of Rs. 60,000 (0.6 Lakh) and the said amount was utilized within 2020-21 and UC has already been submitted in time.


