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DR. BHUPENDRA NATH DUTTA SMRITI MAHAVIDYALAYA: AN OVERVIEW:

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya is a rural college established in 1996 and is associated with the name of Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta, the younger brother of the Vedantic Scientist Swami Vivekananda and a pioneering personality of the glorious Bengal Renaissance. Dr. Dutta's involvement with Hatgobindapur and its surrounding areas went back to the pre-independence days when he was involved to bring about the much-awaited socio-economic development of this rural area. To commemorate his work and contribution, a decision had been taken in a mass meeting in 1983 to establish a General Degree College in the name of Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta and thereafter Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya was established in 1996, as a State Govt. Aided College affiliated to the University of Burdwan.

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta, the younger brother of Warrior Monk Swami Vivekananda was born in Kolkata (Calcutta) in September, 4, 1880. Bhupendra Nath was a noted revolutionary, political thinker, sociologist and foremost figure among the Indian intellectuals. He was associated with Rishi Aurobindo and the Jugantar Group of revolutionaries. Bhupendra Nath Dutta joined the All-India Revolutionary Society and his revolutionary consciousness was expressed in his writings in the weekly *Jugantar* and *Sonar Bangla* for which the British authorities jailed him. At the end of his imprisonment, he sailed to America and after graduating from the New York University in 1912, he earned a Masters' Degree from the Brown University in 1914. During his visit in Southern Europe in 1915, he came across other Indian revolutionaries and was elected as the Secretary of the Berlin Committee for the period of 1916 – 1918. Simultaneously, with his revolutionary activities, he carried out academic research in Sociology and Anthropology that earned him his Doctorate Degree from Hamburg University in 1923. This immensely gifted revolutionary scholar authored a number of books that included among other Indian Social System (3 volumes), "Dialectics of Hindu Ritualism" and "Agony of the Age". He was regarded as the most illustrious figure of the Bengal Renaissance and a dedicated nationalist. A firm believer in socialism, he had propounded the theory of the emergence of feudalism in the Indian context of the early medieval period. He had worked extensively on the nature of land holding in India and particularly was passionate about the land economy of Bengal that found reflection in his celebrated work entitled, "Dialectics of Land-Economics of India." Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta was involved in championing the cause of farmers and agricultural workers. One of the Presidents of Bengal Provincial Kisan Sabha, he was elected President twice of All India Trade Union Congress. Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta dedicated his life for the cause of socio-economic advancement of the rural poor and the under-privileged. He passed away at the age of 81, on December 25, 1961.

VISION AND MISSION OF THE COLLEGE:

- (a) To open new avenues for the rural students for enabling them to pursue higher education
- (b) To diffuse knowledge through publishing literary articles and organizing festivals, seminars, workshop etc.
- (c) To impart higher education to socially backward sections of the society
- (d) To introduce job-oriented courses to promote self-employment opportunities
- (e) To give assistance to poor SC, ST and OBC students to continue their higher studies
- (f) To uplift the rural poor through the non-formal vocational courses of education

REPORT OF THE PRINCIPAL:

Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya which was established with unwavering motto of educating the rural people along with profuse number of aboriginals. We are always keep in direct contact with the students and are accessible to them always even beyond the stipulated college hours. We invariably hear them attentively to erase out even their minute snag to ease their class attending habits. We personally encourage the students to come regularly to be more attentive to their classes.

We have organized Basant Utsav, the festival of colours during spring time to gear up or energize the all students and teachers and education staff members after prolonged pandemic inertia.

We celebrated 'Van mahotsav' or 'Forest Festival' in the first week of July, 2021 by planting of saplings in the college premises with the organization of a Seminar.

We have organized orientation programme for Semester – I students for subject choice, scholarship availability, Credit Card Facility and about regular attendance etc.

Career Counselling programme has undertaken in Auditorium with the presence of nearly 200 students. They were delivered lectures on different aspects of career opportunities. Question- answer session was there to fulfil the inquisitiveness from all streams of students. They were delighted and students of tribal community have requested to include their parents in future to get rid of their age old traditions of early marriage and so on. We gladly accepted their prayer and appreciated such kind of openness.

We have organized a 3-Day International Webinar on "Rejuvenating Values in Indian Context" on January 21 to 23, 2022 by the Department of Philosophy in association with IQAC. The speakers were Prof. Sabujkoli Sen, Principal School of Languages RKMIC, Former Professor of Philosophy & Ex-Vice Chancellor, Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan; Prof. M. Matiur Rahman, Professor, Department of Philosophy, University of Dhaka; Prof. Santosh Kumar Pal, Professor, Department of Philosophy, The University of Burdwan; Dr. Samim Ahmed, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Philosophy; Ramkrishna Mission Vidyamandira, Belur, Howrah and last but not least Mr. Manoranjan Prasad Sing, Assistant Professor, Department of Philosophy, Presidency University, Kolkata. Students and teachers highly acclaimed such Seminar and an appeal came from the teaching community to organize another Seminar covering Science and Philosophy in future. In the year 2021 – 2022 number of students appeared 532, out of which 527 students qualified. In the stream of B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com (Hons & Gen) 473, 42, 17 students appeared for the Sixth Semester examination. The percentage of passed out in the stream of B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com (Hons & Gen) are 99, 100 and 100 respectively. In the college 100% Hons. Students of B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com got 1st class. In B.Com. (Gen) 100% students got 1st class in B.Sc. (Gen) 64% got 1st class, B.A. (Gen) 85% students got 1st class.

Keeping in mind the needs of the students, IQAC of the college organized a one day seminar on discriminatory gender supremacy (“Baishamyabadi lingopravutya O Akhyan Katha”) on 29/04/2022.


