Faculty Feedback on the syllabus

➤ Data Collection for 2020-21:

Feedback is a great reinforce for learning and achievement (Mathew B.P., 2020). It has a significant impact on students' academic achievement. Positive feedback can motivate others to take action, which benefits both teaching and learning. Dr. Bhupendra Nath Dutta Smriti Mahavidyalaya collects the faculty' feedback on different dimensions of the Curriculum. The input was collected in an online google form from Faculty of the college and then assessed using the Likert scale's arithmetic computation. Finally, the findings have been considered about development, the teaching-learning process, and other critical topics. A total of 63 faculty from all department of the college have answered about the 8 parameters of the faculty input on the Curriculum.

Methodology:

To judge these aspects, the rating scale technique has been adopted with five different points – excellent, good, fair, poor, and very poor. For proper quantification, arithmetic scale (5, 4, 3, 2, and 1) has been assigned against this five-point scale, five (5) for 'excellent', four (4) for 'good,' and so on. Different numbers (n5 for 'excellent', n4 for 'good' and so on) of opinions have been quantified with the help of the following equation. Total score of 'Understanding of the Course' = $(5 \times n5 + 4 \times n4 + 3 \times n3 + 2 \times n2 + 1 \times n1) / N$. Thereafter all the derived scores have been presented in table no. 1 and has haven used for evaluation.

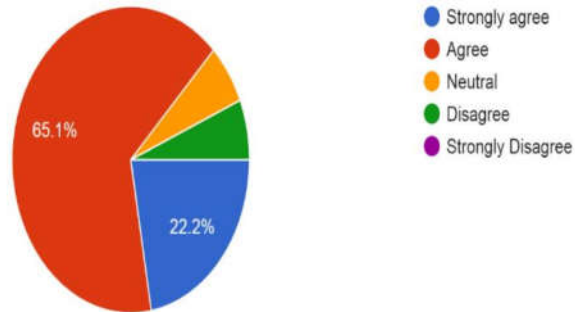

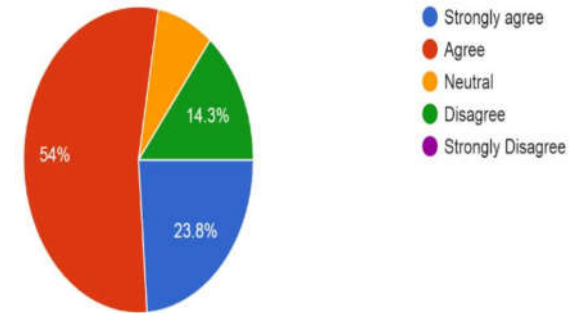
1. Course outcomes mentioned in the syllabus are well defined and clear

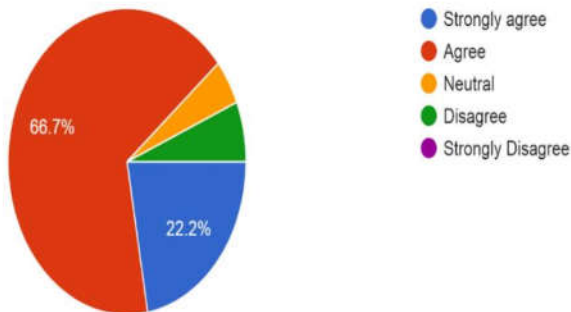
2. The syllabus provides proper scope of experiential learning and critical thinking

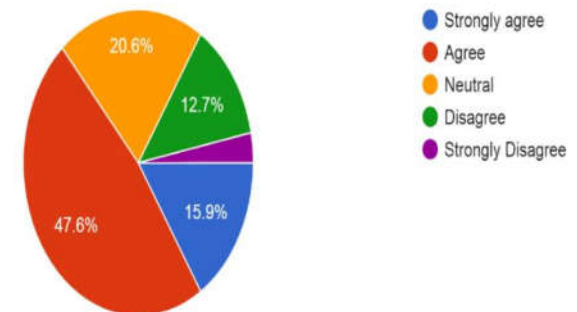
3. The syllabus is need based and updated at regular intervals

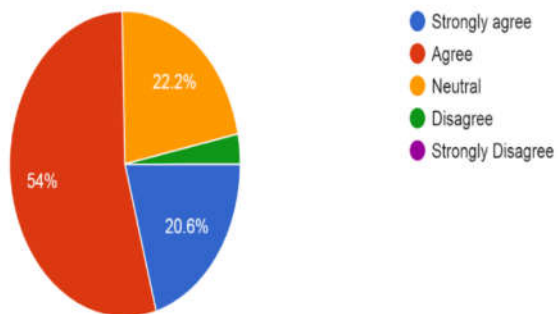
4. There is a proper balance between the theoretical and practical learning experiences

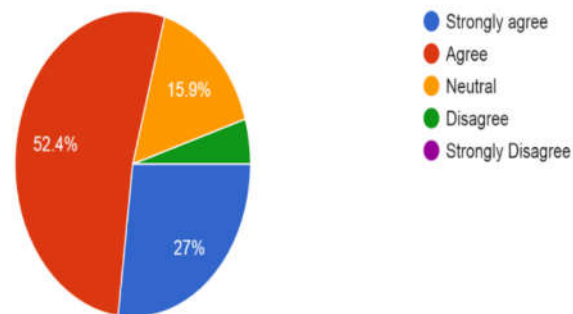
5. The course curriculum is appropriately designed to make students ready for higher studies and job opportunities

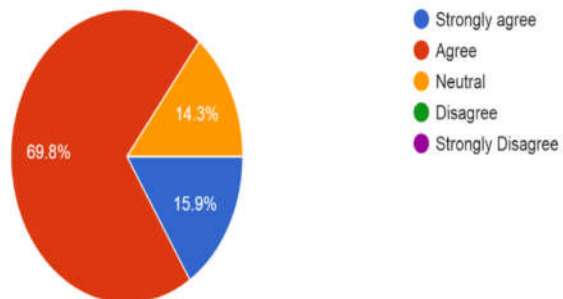
6. The curriculum includes courses to sensitize students towards the cross cutting issues such as gender, ethics, human values, environment and sustainability
